3. Weather:

The scheduled time for the event is the middle of the summer in the United States.

The average temperatures in Dayton Ohio are 61 to 82 degrees F (16 to 28 degrees C).

A shuttle bus service is being worked with each of the event hotels to be available to transport teams from the hotel to the airfield and back each day. Final details will be published in future bulletins.

We are also expecting a large number of spectators from all over the World to attend the JWM.

5. Food:

- Many of the hotels offer a complimentary breakfast
- Most of the hotels are near major restaurants and several have restaurants located within their hotels.
- Lunch will be available for purchase at the event site at reasonable prices
- Dinner each evening will be at a local restaurant of your choosing; except for the Nations Night and the Closing Banquet.
- The “opening party” will be held at the event site on the back field of the National Museum of the USAF at no cost to the participants
- Nations night will be held on Monday, August 1st; tickets will be available for purchase during team check-in; ticket price will be announced in a future bulletin
- The closing banquet will be held on Saturday, August 6th; tickets will be available for purchase during team check-in; ticket price will be announced in a future bulletin

6. Entry fees (payment not due at time of registration – see Item # 16):

8. Official Language:

English is the official language of the IJMC, and will be used throughout the competition.

9. Registration:

a) General Information:

- 1) On-line registration begins on November 1, 2010 (www.jwm2011.com).
- 2) Last day to register is March 15, 2011.
- 3) Any registrations received after March 15, 2011 may not be honored.
- 4) Complete all forms and provide requested photos of all team members (team manager, pilots, helpers, and supporters) and models.
- 5) Registrations without photos cannot be honored as your picture becomes a part of a pass for your access to restricted areas (see additional guidance in paragraph 9d below).
- 6) Your prompt registration will better insure your acceptance as a competitor.
- 7) Early registration will also enable us to organize the event in the best possible manner and will help us to make sure that everything will be arranged and ready for your arrival.
- 8) The registration includes only the registration fees for attending the competition: Team Manager, Pilots, Helpers & Supporters. All other orders and payments for social activities (such as Nations Night and the Closing Banquet) will be done separately during the arrival/check-in process at the JWM event location.

b) Deadline for Teams Registration: Forms 1 - 4

- 1) The Team Manager will complete Registration Forms 1 – 4 and send them as soon as possible but no later than March 15, 2011.

c) Registration Form Instructions:

- 1) Registration Forms are:
 - a) Form 1 –Team Manager, Pilots, & Helpers
 - b) Form 2 - Photographs for Team Manager, Pilots, and Helpers
 - c) Form 3 –Supporters and Photographs for Supporters
 - d) Form 4 – Model details and photographs
- 2) Supporter's late registration:
 - a) In order to have as many Supporters as part of the Teams, we will accept Supporter's registration until May 1, 2011.
 - b) These registrations need to be submitted on Form 3 and Signed by the Team Manager.
- 3) ALL completed registration forms must be sent by Team Managers only. All forms should be sent to: david.thomas@wpafb.af.mil

d) Registration Photographs:

- 1) All team managers, pilots, helpers and supporters are asked to provide a digital photograph (Passport style) of chest and head only, 1 inch x 1 inch (2 ½ cm x 2 1/2 cm) Pasted in the appropriate Forms # 2 or 3.
- 2) Due to safety and insurance liability, providing a picture is a must and will be used to produce the official identification passes for use during the event, as well for the Event Brochure.
- 3) Unfortunately, we cannot issue any passes without pictures. So any person who does not provide a photograph **will not be** issued a pass and will have limited or no access to facilities and restricted areas.

e) Photo Identification Pass Distribution:

- 1) During the on-site registration/check-in process, we will ask the team managers to pick up the passes for their team members.

f) Airfield Access Limitations:

- 1) The active flying airfield will require separate access for the pilot's helpers and supporters.
- 2) Spectators will be restricted from the active flying airfield. Their admission to the JWM competition will be free of charge.
- 3) Spectators will be permitted into the model storage hangar; however they will be required to stay within the barricaded walkway areas (they will not be permitted to the model table area)

g) Registration Questions:

- 1) All communications with the organizers must be through the team managers.
- 2) Information collected on the registration forms will be used by the organizers solely for the necessary purposes of controlling the event.
- 3) Names, countries, and photos will be used for the publications, event brochure, and announcer commentary.

10. National flags and anthems:

Each national team is requested to bring:

- One standard outdoor national flag with grommet holes (see photo below) on the top and bottom of the width side of the flag for securing to a pole
- Flag dimensions should be approximately 900 mm width by 1500 mm length (or 3 ft width by 5 ft length)



- A CD (or .mp3 file) of your country's national anthem.

11. Fuel, Gas, Compressed Air:

Due to airline restrictions on the transportation of jet fuel and oil, supplies will be available on-site for competitors to obtain and mix their own fuel.

12. Alternative Runway:

Due to the location of the National Museum of the USAF and its proximity to the Air Force Base, there is no alternate runway available. Practice flight times will be available for each pilot prior to competition start.

13. Insurance:

To be determined (TBD).

14. Passports/Visas/Immigration:

All international travelers must be in possession of a valid passport (preferably one that is valid for at least 6 months after the 2011 JWM.)

All international travelers must be in possession of a U.S. visa.

Those international travelers who are seeking to travel to the United States under the Visa Waiver Program are now subject to enhanced security requirements. All eligible travelers who wish to travel under the Visa Waiver Program must apply for authorization using the Electronic System for Travel Authorization web site at: <https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/esta/jsp/printfull.jsp> Currently those countries participating in the Visa Waiver Program are: Andorra, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brunei, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, San Marino, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom. If you receive an approved waiver, it is valid for 2 years from the date of issue and it is strongly recommended that you print a copy of the confirmation and keep it with your passport.

Any international travelers from countries not participating in the Visa Waiver Program will need to follow the standard “paper U.S. visa” process. This process will require the traveler to obtain a U.S. visa from the United States Embassy or Consulate in the traveler’s country to process a “nonimmigrant visa” for entering the USA. Once the U.S. visa is obtained, it should be kept with the traveler’s passport at all times.

15. Security passes and restricted areas:

- Photo security badges will be made for each team manager, pilot, helper, and supporter
- Only those individuals with the photo security badges will be permitted access to the models in the “Model Storage Hangar”
- Any photo security badge holder may escort a guest to the model area. However, the escort must remain with the guest and is responsible for the actions of the guest.
- Overnight security will be provided at the event site by the organizer.

16. Payments and Bank Transfers:

After the Team Managers return the Registration Forms, we will send each Team Manager an invoice with the exact amount to be transferred. All payments must be made by Bank Transfer; one transfer for each Team.

17. Updates:

18. Family and Friends:

All family members and friends must be registered as supporters. We will not allow any other visitors to go into the restricted areas.

19. Electricity on site:

On the site and in the hangars you will have access to 60 Hz/110Volt power (the American standard). Each team may wish to bring a power converter and plug adapters to the American standard outlet.



The organizers will provide a limited amount of 12 volt DC inverters for team use.

20. Last Day - Air Show:

21. Model Crates (Transport and Shipment):

Team Members:

- 1) Each pilot must determine and arrange for the most advantageous air cargo shipment company to transport their model crate from the home country to the United States and return to the origin; both legs.
- 2) If you have chosen FedEx, UPS, or DHL, they will transport door-to-door.
- 3) If you choose a commercial airline (such as: Delta, Air France, British Airways, United Airlines, etc.), then the following procedures apply if routed through Chicago O'Hare:
 - a. Arrangements have been made with a Chicago O'Hare Airport Brokerage Firm, Trans Group, to receive all crate shipments, process them through Customs & store them in their warehouse until they have a semi-truck load, then deliver directly to the Museum.
 - b. The price for Customs Clearance Temporary Importation Bond (TIB) will be approximately \$6 USD per crate. This includes the cost for both the import and export of the crate.
 - c. All airlines at the Chicago O'Hare airport will charge a \$50 USD Terminal Fee for processing the import of each crate.
 - d. The price for transport to the Museum will be approximately \$150 USD per crate. This fee includes transport from Chicago O'Hare to the JWM site and return transport to Chicago O'Hare.
 - e. We will ask for your TIB, Terminal Fee, & Truck Transport reimbursement during check-in at the JWM.
 - f. The crates should be scheduled for delivery to Chicago O'Hare Airport **no later than** July 21, 2011.
 - g. Crates arriving later may be charged a higher delivery fee to the Museum depending on the number on the last truck load.
 - h. The return of the crates to their origins will be exactly the reverse of the original shipment. All return shipping fees with an Air Way Bill (AWB) must be done at the time of your original shipping arrangements at your home country.
- 4) The model crate shipping labels to the United States should read:

- 5) A return address label for your model crate must be provided by each pilot at the conclusion of the JWM and affixed to the model crate by the pilot.

- 8) Shipments by any other means must be handled directly by the model owner or pilot.
- 9) Each pilot should investigate with their own country any advance registration required of the model to ensure there are no import or export issues. The pilot will want to ensure the model can be easily received in their home country on return shipment and not be subjected to a duty tax.

22. Spectators and guests:

For the benefit of spectators and guests, special barriers and passages will be provided inside the model storage hangar which will allow the spectators to view the models and pilots up close. It will be at a reasonably safe distance with security and thus allowing good close access to all the models. Only properly photo badged team managers, pilots, helpers, and supporters may have the clearance to go beyond the security fence inside the model storage hangar and special passages.

24. Miscellaneous:

Arriving details of Team Members:

- Please verify with your team manager that they have informed the 2011 JWM organizers of your exact day and time of arrivals - please make sure to send all info (destination airport (Dayton Ohio, Cincinnati Ohio, or Columbus Ohio), airline, flight number, day and time of arrival, rental car company) to: David Thomas (david.thomas@wpafb.af.mil) – National Museum of the US Air Force – JWM Event Coordinator.
- One of the organizer's representatives will be waiting for you in the luggage claim area of the appropriate airport (Dayton, Cincinnati, Columbus) to make sure you arrived safely and that you know how to get to your hotel and the National Museum of the United States Air Force.

Excursion Activities:

- The organizer will provide a pamphlet upon arrival on all the available excursion activities that your team may participate in while here for the JWM.
- The same information is available now the JWM website (www.jwm2011.com).
- You may desire to rent a car while in the United States. Train/rail service and bus transportation is not as readily available as what can be found in many other countries. Many of the excursion opportunities will necessitate you to drive to the activity.
